Under 900 bottles are made of this wine that comes from a 100-year-old vineyard site, planted in an amphitheatre in Tirapu just south of Pamplona. The Garnacha here offers a floral expression of the variety with gorgeous violet and rose alongside an explosion of red cherries and raspberry. Chalky tannins with some spice on the finish give this wine a fresh lift. It is light without being light on flavour and is charmingly rustic in the best sense of the word.

The 2021 Artaxo is pure Garnacha from two old vineyards in Artajona and Artazu that are organically farmed but not certified. It fermented with 15% full clusters and indigenous yeasts and matured in used 300- and 500-liter French oak barrels for 10 months. It has good ripeness at 14.9% alcohol while keeping a low pH and remarkable acidity. This is serious, harmonious and different, with lots of acid berry fruit. It's textured and telluric, mysterious and characterful, with a medium to full-bodied palate and volume but freshness. 2021 seems to be a very good vintage here. 1,200 bottles produced. It was bottled in February 2023.

No 2020 was produced.

The 2021 La Tapada was produced with Garnacha from an organically farmed (but not certified) 1.5-hectare 70-year-old vineyard in the village of Azagra, one of a handful of villages from Navarra that are included within Rioja, but it's sold without appellation of origin. It fermented with indigenous yeasts in stainless steel and Flextank and matured in used 225-liter oak barrels, Flextanks and glass demijohn for 12 months. It has good ripeness, 14.5% alcohol, good freshness and acidity and a paler, brighter color. I love the elegance here. The wine is fine-boned and fresh, with less alcohol and more acidity. It feels fresher.

6,000 bottles produced. It was bottled in March 2023.

Luis Moya works with six parcels to produce this Garnacha that sees some oak (500L) as well as a little tinaja for around a year. The acidity is very typical of the northern parts of Navarra, direct and precise, and perfectly balances the concentration of the fruit. It's minty fresh and spicy with red fruits and some darker berries, and while it is inherently elegant, it is not overworked. Delightfully honest and repeatable!

The 2020 Korteta is a red blend of 92% Garnacha and 8% Graciano from six different vineyards where he makes wines like Artaxo, Ostoki, La Tapada or El Yesal. Here, Graciano makes the blend sharper and energetic. It's ripe without excess at 14.3% alcohol and has a low pH of 3.42 and good acidity. It fermented with 10% full clusters and matured in used 225- and 300-liter French oak barrels and some glass demijohns and small tinajas for 10 months. It's juicy and tender, with 'ne tannins, very pleasant. 3,000 bottles produced. It was bottled in November 2022.

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LMT Wines, Cerro Amurdi Clarete 2022

Now for something different... A very pale pink clarete produced mostly from Pinot Noir (60%) and Garnacha (30%) with Riesling, Garnacha Blanca and Chardonnay making up the rest of the blend. Very minimalist winemaking – direct press with fermentation in stainless steel – results in this delightful interpretation of an unusual field blend from a vineyard in Cizur, just to the south of Pamplona. Grapefruit and rhubarb with some orange peel zest make this a lively and pretty pink.

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There are 1.2 hectares of « exotic » varieties in Cerro Amurdi, close to his winery, so he made a quaffable « clarete, » the 2022 Cerro Amurdi Clarete.

It's a blend of around 60% Pinot Noir, 30% Garnacha and 10% white varieties (Verdejo, Chardonnay, Riesling) that fermented after the direct pressing of the bunches and was bottled after four months with the lees in stainless steel. It has 13% alcohol and very good freshness. It has a bright salmon color and is clean and tasty, with some austerity and a serious, dry palate with a slightly reductive character that, to me, makes it much more serious. 600 bottles were filled in March 2023. Drink 2023-2026.
